HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for graduation and specified alternative means for completing the prescribed course of study shall be made available to students, parents/guardians, and the public. (Education Code 51225.3)

In the annual notification sent to parents/guardians pursuant to Education Code 48980, the County Superintendent or designee shall include the following: (Education Code 48980)

1. Information about high school graduation requirements and how each requirement satisfies or does not satisfy the subject matter requirements for admission to the California State University and the University of California.
2. A complete list of career technical education courses offered by the County Superintendent that satisfy the subject matter requirements for admission to the California State University and the University of California, and which of the specific college admission requirements these courses satisfy.

If a student successfully completes the graduation requirements of his or her school district of residence while being detained, the school district of residence shall issue to the student a diploma from the school the student last attended before detention, or in the alternative, the County Superintendent may issue a diploma. (Education Code 48645.5)
