Students PRESCHOOL/EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

The County Superintendent and County Board recognize that high-quality preschool experiences help children ages 3-4 years to enhance social-emotional development, knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary for a successful transition into the elementary education program. Such programs should provide developmentally appropriate activities in a safe, adequately supervised, and cognitively rich environment.

Collaboration with Community Programs

The County Superintendent or designee may collaborate with other agencies, organizations, and/or private preschool providers to assess the availability of preschool programs throughout the county and the extent to which the preschool needs are being met. The County Board and the County Superintendent believe that all Fresno County children should have access to high quality preschool programs.
